This competition is organized under the financial support of Bank of Maharashtra, Kolhapur and Rote Trust, Kolhapur. The topics for the competition are collected from college teachers, keen observers of society, students of Jainism and jain literature and finally they are scrutinized and selected. During the last academic year, 43rd Bhagwan Mahavir State Level Elocution Competition was successfully organized at the college.
